TEACHING ASSIGNMENTS

TAPS 2400 – Introduction to Stagecraft (Governors State University) 3 credits

This course focuses on the processes in the construction of scenery to be used for theatrical performances and basics of the design concepts that develop it. This introductory, hands-on course centers on learning and experiencing the personnel, crafts, tools and materials used in scenery construction for the theatre. We will explore how all areas (lighting, sound, costume) work in unison with the scene shop.

TAPS 1100 – Theatre Appreciation (Governors State University) 3 credits

This course introduces theatre/drama as a performing art form. Includes study and analysis of historical, social, aesthetic and technical aspects of the traditional and contemporary theatrical and dramatic expression.

TAPS 4090 – Theatre Design and Production (Governors State University) 3 credits

This course examines the world of theatrical design and its processes. By exploring the design and production elements of scenery, lighting, costumes and sound, students will discover the theory and craft of each of these areas that comprise the field of theatrical design and technical production. Beginning with the script, we will look at the problem–solving and conceptual thinking necessary for each of theatrical practices. Focus of course is to foster the development of process that enables students to make creative choices that lead to development of designs that both serve the play and solve technical challenges in theatrical productions.

DRM 155 - Ethnic Traditions in American Theatre (South Suburban College) 3 credits

This course examines the various dramatic expressions that reflect the experience and construction of racial or cultural minority identity in the United States. Students will explore ethnic identity from the Civil War era to the present day by focusing on specific stock-character types, performers, and playwrights and their creations as well as circumstances of the day that incited such expression.

DRM 151 Theatre Appreciation (South Suburban College) 3 credits

The focus of this course is the theatre experience as seen through its history, plays, major movements, and conventions. Students will survey genres (comedy, tragedy, farce, melodrama, musical theatre), read select plays, identify what makes theatre different than film, and discuss the theatricality of stage elements (script, set, lights, actors, etc.), both individually and together as they form a whole. Attendance at a live theatre production is included

T100 Introduction to Theatre (Indiana University Northwest) 4 credits

This course is an overview of theories, methodologies and skills. Great emphasis will be placed on Theatre as a composite art. Relationship of various components: play, playwright, actor, director, designer, audience, critic and physical theater. Focus on enhancing critical thinking about the performing arts.

T225 Stagecraft 1 (Indiana University Northwest) 3 credits

This course is an introduction to theories, methodology and skills; analysis of practical and aesthetic functions of stage scenery, fundamentals of scenic construction and rigging, mechanical drawing for stagecraft. Lecture and Skills Lab.

T225 Scene Design 1 (Indiana University Northwest) 3 credits

This course is an introduction to the process of scene design, research and idea development, scene designer's responsibilities, scene problem solving and exploration of visual materials and forms.

T335 Stage Lighting 1 (Indiana University Northwest) 3 credits

This course is an introduction to theories, methodology and skills: instruments and their use, control of light, practical applications and theatrical concepts. Students will be encouraged to develop methods to present visual images that covey design concepts for lighting.

T438 Lighting Design (Indiana University Northwest) 3 credits

Continuation of developing the skills and methods of lighting design. Emphasis on class projects focusing on color, cueing and instrumentation. We will continue growth of visual morgue of lighting images that can be used to explain and develop lighting environments needed to create the "world of the play." Projects will include actual design work for realized productions and class presentations.

Lighting Design Consultant (Homewood Flossmoor High School) non-credit/extra-curricular

Work with the students at the high school to assist in the development of the design and production elements in the department's theatre and music department. Design the lighting for productions with an eye to walking the students through the development process of design and implementation of lighting a production. To work with students who show interest in designing. By working closely with these student help to identify and develop young theatre artists. Guide the students toward undergraduate programs in the theatre arts.

Eureka College Theatre Project – Lighting (paid summer workshop)

A weeklong summer Theatre workshop for high school students, college students and high school teachers. This is a process-oriented workshop where classes emphasize the process of theater. Through lecture and projects, students are exposed to the art and process of a lighting designer.

B-40 Stagecraft/Scenery Lab (Northwestern University - Graduate Assistant)

This undergraduate lab course is coupled with the B and C level Scenery courses. During these daily labs, students participate in construction of all aspects of the mainstage productions. Students are taught techniques for scenery and prop construction. Students are assigned to and supervised as they participate in the actual running of the productions.

B-40 Scenery - Drafting Lab (Northwestern University - Graduate Assistant)

Undergraduate course in conjunction with B-40 Scenery. Students are taught basics of mechanical drafting. Assignments are actual draftings in which certain aspects of drafting are emphasized, i.e., line weight, lettering and construction.

B-40 Scenery - Lighting Lab (Northwestern University - Graduate Assistant)

Course in conjunction with B-40 Lighting. Students work with equipment and learn to hang and focus a light plot. Included are fundamentals of electricity and equipment usage. Also included is learning how to read a light plot and its supplemental paperwork.
